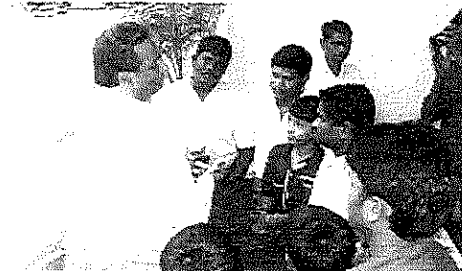

Reaching the lost in India

The Lord is much bigger than the world that He has created. The Kumar's, Brethren pastors and evangelists in India continue to reach out in dozens of ways to transform lives and develop new disciples. In 2018, Brethren churches in India baptized over 300 new believers!

Brethren Medical Clinic

Known as the one rupee hospital, the clinic serves people with basic medical needs. Handing out Tylenol, antibiotic creams, and eye drops, etc. quickly found on a shelf in the United States. Doctors provide first aid and give over-the-counter medications. This small care makes a huge difference for those who do not have access to medical care or supplies.



Sewing School

The sewing school takes 50 students per year, 25 per class, through a ten-month training process. They teach pattern making, garment mending, and sewing. At completion, students take a government test for certification, allowing them to find work or start micro-businesses. The sewing school teaches sustainable work and keeps women out of dangerous human trafficking risk.
