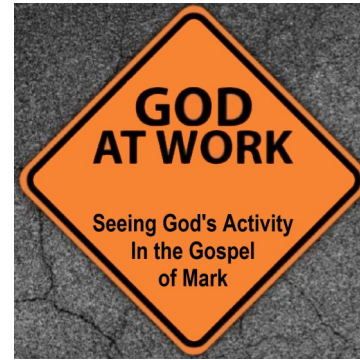
Prayer Concerns–
