- Praise that Riley Miller was rebaptized last Sunday

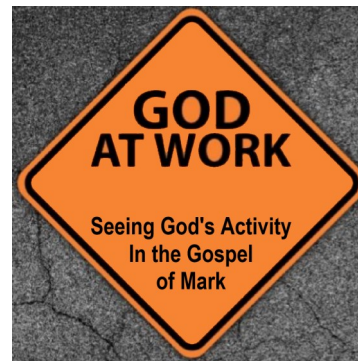
