**Upcoming Sermons:**

**June 18th–** *Four Creatures and a Call– Ezekiel 1– God calls a young man named Ezekiel to ministry in one of the strangest prophetic visions recorded in Scripture. And God gives him a nickname- “Watchman.”*

**June 25th–** *Scattered– Ezekiel 5-6– God foretells that His people will be scattered to the wind, not simply as punishment, but in order to purify His people. This, we learn, is the real purpose of exile.*

**July 2nd–** *The Glory Leaves the Temple– Ezekiel 8 & 10– Since Moses’ time, the glory of God dwelled in the Holy of Holies of the place He chose for His Name to be worshipped. But because of the people’s wicked idolatry, Ezekiel saw God do the unthinkable– abandon His dwelling place!*
